National Churches Trust Grants Awarded 2007

During 2007, the National Churches Trust awarded nearly £1.5m in grants towards the restoration of church buildings across the UK. The Grants Committee, which meets quarterly, is comprised of a selection of Trustees as well as independent experts from the church and heritage sectors. In 2008, the Trust increased its funding to £2m per year in conjunction with the implementation of a new Grants Programme. This programme was developed in response to growing demand and a steady increase in the cost of repair work. Additional funding has also been made available to improve access to, and facilities within, churches in order to encourage their wider use by the local community.
