



Saint David Lewis	Treated both the rich and the poor equally. Looked after the spiritual and physical needs of his parish even when it was dangerous to do so.	Celebrated Mass for them and helped them live a faith filled life. Helped them to survive the physical hardships of being poor such as hunger, and the hardship of being unable to live their faith freely.
