

PARTNERSHIP GRANTS

55 churches and chapels in England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland are set to benefit from rescue funding of £425,183 from the National Churches Trust, the UK's church support charity.

Awarded in March 2018, 4 churches receive National Churches Trust Partnership Grants for urgent repair projects, awarded on the recommendation of local church trusts in England, and to churches in Northern Ireland.

CORNWALL

Warleggan, St Bartholomew

Anglican, Diocese of St Albans, Grade II*

£5,000 Partnership Grant

In partnership with the Cornwall Historic Churches Trust

Awarded £5,000 for repairs to the tower parapet and bell chamber.

LEICESTERSHIRE

Orton on the Hill, St Edith of Polesworth

Anglican, Diocese of St Leicester, Grade I

£2,500 Partnership Grant

In partnership with the LeicesterShire Historic Churches Trust

Awarded £2,500 for repairs to the rainwater goods and below-ground drainage.

NORTHERN IRELAND

Portadown, St Mark

Anglican, Diocese of St Armagh, Grade B

£10,000 Partnership Grant

Awarded £10,000 to replace missing slates, loose masonry, support the beam in the bell tower, gutter work, and stonework pointing.

STAFFORDSHIRE

Calton, St Mary the Virgin

Anglican, Diocese of St Lichfield, Grade II

£5,000 Partnership Grant

In partnership with the Staffordshire Historic Churches Trust

Awarded £5,000 for repairs to the nave roof and timber bellcote.
