

## How welcoming is your place of worship?

Is your church normally open between services?	
If it is closed, is a key available?	
Is there a 'welcoming' notice at the door?	
Is there a prominent notice giving times of services?	
Is there an invitation for people to attend the next service?	
Is there an invitation to pray or to leave a prayer request?	
Is there literature available about your church?	
If yes, is it attractively produced?	
Is your church guide available in a variety of formats e.g. large print, Braille, or audiotape?	
Are copies of your church magazine on display?	
Are copies of the Diocesan newspaper on display, with an invitation to take one?	
Is there any literature about the wider work of the church or mission activities?	
Is there a mission statement clearly on display?	
Is there a list of church ministers and officers?	
Are there photographs on display of the minister and PCC members?	
Are there photographs on display of church activities?	
Is there a noticeboard / church website advertising forthcoming church activities?	
If yes, is your noticeboard / church website attractive, current and informative? Does your website comply with accessibility guidelines?	
Are notices and publicity materials printed in a sans serif font of the appropriate size?	
Is publicity printed on appropriately coloured card or paper?	
If you have items for sale is it clear where money is to be placed?	
Is your church tidy and free of clutter?	
Does your church look gloomy or is there plenty of light around the porch and entrance area?	
Would a visitor find your church 'welcoming'?	
Would they find someone there to welcome them?	
Are your welcomers trained to assist people with disabilities?
